### Do You Have an Answer to Life's Greatest Question?

Life's greatest question is, "Are you prepared to meet God?" God tells us in the Bible, "Prepare to meet thy God." Amos 4:12

Here's how you can prepare to meet Him and know that when the time comes for you to stand before Him, you'll be ready:

1. Acknowledge what God says about all men: that we have sinned and come short of His glory. (Romans 3:23). Admit that you have sinned and are, therefore, a sinner. (Romans 3:10)

2. Recognize that God loves sinners and that He loves you, so much so that He sent His only begotten Son, Jesus Christ, to die for you so that you could live forever with Him. (Romans 5:8)

3. By faith, turn to God through His Son, Jesus Christ, from your sins. This is called repentance in the Bible and it is simply a change of mind about who you are (a sinner) and who God is (a Savior). In repentance you are saying, "I am a sinner and Christ is my only hope for salvation. I trust Him and Him alone."

4. Believing in your heart that Christ died




